PRICE SITUATIONER OF SELECTED AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES

FIRST WEEK OF NOVEMBER 2018

- Retail prices of rice during the week decrease in some regional centers (Table 1).
 - A kilogram of premium rice declined by P1.00 in three regional centers during the week.
 - The price of a kilogram of well milled rice dropped by P1.00 in Cabanatuan City and Cagayan de Oro City and by P6.00 in Baguio City. Meanwhile, it increased by P1.00 per kilogram in Iloilo City and Butuan City.
 - A price cut of P1.00 per kilogram of regular milled rice was noticed in Tacloban City and by P2.00 per kilogram in both Cagayan de Oro City and Davao City. However, it picked up by P1.00 per kilogram in Butuan City.
- Prevailing retail prices of meat and poultry items generally remain unchange during the week (Table 2).
 - A P10.00 per kilogram of beef lean meat and beef with bones were both priced lower in Cabanatuan City.
 - Price of pork lean meat went down by P20.00 per kilogram in San Fernando City (Region 1) and by P10.00 per kilogram in Tuguegarao City.
- Selected fish species are priced lower in some regional centers during the week (Table 3).
 - The price of a kilogram of bangus fell by P10.00 in Batangas City and Davao City; by P20.00 in Baguio City; and by P50.00 in San Fernando City (Region 1). On the other hand, it climbed by P10.00 in the National Capital Region (NCR).
 - Prices of tilapia were priced lower from P10.00 to P30.00 per kilogram in five regional centers.
- Mixed price movements are noted in vegetables this week (Table 4).
 - Price mark-ups ranging from P5.00 to P40.00 per kilogram of ampalaya were posted in five regional centers.
 - Four regional centers registered price gains ranging from P20.00 to P50.00 per kilogram of cabbage during the week. Meanwhile, it was cheaper from P10.00 to P55.00 per kilogram in five regional centers.
 - Prices of carrots dropped from P10.00 to P40.00 per kilogram in seven regional centers.
 - Price increases in eggplant from P10.00 to P50.00 per kilogram during the week were noted in seven regional centers.
 - Price cuts ranging from P5.00 to P30.00 per kilogram of habitchuelas were posted in seven regional centers.
 - A kilogram of tomato went up from P5.00 to P30.00 in nine regional centers.





5. Varied prices changes in condiments are observed during the period (Table 5).
- Price cuts ranging from P5.00 to P20.00 per kilogram for imported garlic were posted in four regional centers.
 - A kilogram of ginger hawaiian was cheaper from P5.00 to P10.00 in four regional centers. Meanwhile, it climbed by P10.00 in Batangas City and by P25.00 in Cabanatuan City.
6. Prevailing prices of fruits generally maintain their previous week's levels (Table 6).
- The price of a kilogram of mango carabao was lower by P10.00 in Butuan City; by P15.00 in NCR; and by P20.00 in Tuguegarao City.
 - A kilogram of papaya increased by P10.00 in Batangas City and by P25.00 in Zamboanga City.
7. Prices of other commodities decrease in some regional centers (Table 7).
- A price cut of P2.00 per bottle of cooking oil was observed in Kidapawan City and by P5.00 in Cabanatuan City.
 - The price of a kilogram of refined sugar went down by P7.00 in Cabanatuan City and by P9.00 in Cagayan de Oro City.
