**SUBJECT** : IMPLEMENTATION OF PHILIPPINE PASSPORT ACT 1996  
(R.A. 8239)

The NSO is one of the agencies involved in the implementation of the new Passport Law.

Under Section 5b of the law it provides that:

Section 5. Requirements from the Issuance of Passport - No passport shall be issued to an applicant unless the Secretary or his duly authorized representative is satisfied that the applicant is a Filipino Citizen who has complied with the following requirement:

- a. xxx
- b. The birth certificate duly issued or authenticated by the office of the Civil Registrar General: provided, however, that if the birth of the applicant have not been registered yet, or if his birth certificate is destroyed, damaged, or not available due to other causes, he shall apply for delayed registration or his birth with the office of the Civil Registrar General which shall issue to said applicant to certification of pending application for damaged registration of birth attaching thereto a copy of an accomplished Certificate of Live Birth. Such certification and the accomplished COLB shall be sufficient to support an application for passport in addition to other papers which the Department may secure from the applicant.


