Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Week 3 of December 2020

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1. The average retail prices of dressed chicken increased by PhP 1.88 to PhP 20.00 per kilogram in eight regional centers during the period. Meanwhile, its average retail price per kilogram dropped by PhP 15.00 in Baguio City. (Table 1)
2. Galunggong was priced lower by PhP 3.00 to PhP 48.00 per kilogram in seven regional centers during the week. On the other hand, its average retail price per kilogram went up by PhP 8.00 in Cebu City, and by PhP 44.00 in San Fernando City (Region 1). (Table 2)
3. On the average, retail prices of vegetables were lower in many regional centers during the period. (Table 3)
4. Price cuts, ranging from PhP 2.00 to PhP 42.29 per kilogram of red onion, were noted in 11 regional centers during the period. However, its average retail price per kilogram climbed by PhP 8.00 in San Fernando City (Region 1) and Iloilo City (Region 6). (Table 4)
5. Calamansi was priced higher by PhP 2.00 to PhP 24.00 per kilogram in seven regional centers. Meanwhile, its average retail price per kilogram declined by PhP 1.00 in Cabanatuan City (Region 3) and by PhP 8.00 in Butuan City. (Table 5)
6. Increments in the average retail prices of a kilogram of sugar in the National Capital Region (NCR) ranged from PhP 0.30 to PhP 0.43 during the period. Likewise, the average retail price of 485 ml of cooking oil in NCR and Iloilo City picked up by PhP 2.22 and PhP 5.00, respectively, during the week. (Table 6)


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
