Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities Week 2 of September 2020

Date of Release: 16 September 2020

1. Four regional centers exhibited price changes in rice during the week, which ranged from PhP 1.00 to PhP 4.00 per kilogram. (Table 1)
2. Prices of beef and pork retained their previous week's levels in all regional centers during the period. (Table 2)
3. A kilogram of galunggong picked up by PhP 10.00 in Baguio City, and by PhP 20.00 in the National Capital Region (NCR), Zamboanga City, and Davao City during the week. (Table 3)
4. Price movements of vegetables vary across regional centers during the period. (Table 4)
5. Eight regional centers recorded price mark-ups in red onion, ranging from PhP 10.00 to PhP 30.00 per kilogram, during the period. Meanwhile, it dropped by PhP 20.00 per kilogram in NCR. (Table 5)
6. Price increases by PhP 10.00 and PhP 20.00 per kilogram of carabao mango were registered in six regional centers. However, it was priced lower by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Batangas City. (Table 6)
7. Prices of other basic commodities remained stable in all regional centers during the week. (Table 7)
