Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Week 3 of September 2020

Date of Release: 23 September 2020

1. Four regional centers posted price decreases in rice, ranging from PhP 1.00 to PhP 4.00 per kilogram, during the week. (Table 1)
2. A kilogram of dressed chicken was priced higher by PhP 5.00 in Cotabato City, by PhP 10.00 in the National Capital Region (NCR), and by PhP 40.00 in Cagayan de Oro City during the period. (Table 2)
3. Price cuts, ranging from PhP 10.00 to PhP 30.00, per kilogram of galunggong were recorded in five regional centers this week. Meanwhile, its price rose by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Cebu City. (Table 3)
4. Mixed price movements in vegetables were observed in many regional centers during the week. (Table 4)
5. Price for a kilogram of red onion increased by PhP 10.00 in Cabanatuan City and Cagayan de Oro City, and by PhP 20.00 in NCR, Davao City, and Butuan City during the week. (Table 5)
6. Price declines, ranging from PhP 5.00 to PhP 22.00, per kilogram of calamansi were noted in six regional centers during the week. However, it was priced higher by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Iloilo City, and by PhP 18.00 per kilogram in Cagayan de Oro City. (Table 6)
7. In Cagayan de Oro City, the price of a kilogram of brown sugar was lower by PhP 3.00, while its refined sugar picked up by PhP 7.00 during the week. (Table 7)
