


PHILIPPINE INFLATION RATE





Among the 13 commodity groups, only three had lower inflation rates: (1) Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages; (2) Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels; and (3) Transport. However, the decreases in the inflation of these three commodity groups were enough to bring down the inflation for all items by 0.9 percentage point since they contributed 76.57 percent of the total
