

In the 7.9% inflation rate for the bottom 30% income households in December 2022, the food and non-alcoholic beverages contributed around 73.9%, indicating that the increa<mark>sed fo</mark>od pri<mark>ce</mark>s dro<mark>ve t</mark>he inflation during the <mark>mon</mark>th.

Among the food groups, the highest contributors are vegetables, rice, and corn with a combined contribution of around 82.3% of the food inflation.
