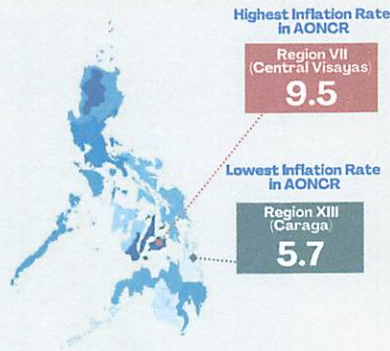

Main Sources of Acceleration: Philippines

The inflation rate for the bottom 30% income households in the Philippines was higher in November 2022 at 7.7% compared with the October 2022 inflation rate of 7.3%, despite the NCR posting lower inflation rate of 9.0% on the same month. This is because NCR only accounts for 3.78% of the total CPI weight in the Philippines. Thus, the inflation trend of the Philippines is largely dictated by the inflation trend of the areas outside NCR.
