compilation of statistical information collected from various government agencies and statistical publications. It is an adoption of the UN Framework


for the Development of Environment Statistics (FDES) 2013.


Component 6: Environment Protection,

This component consists information on expenditures, regulations, and other activities such as international agreements focusing on the protection of the environment and management of resources.





GOVERNMENT ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION EXPENDITURE, 2019














GOVERNMENT CLIMATE CHANGE EXPENDITURE, 2019




