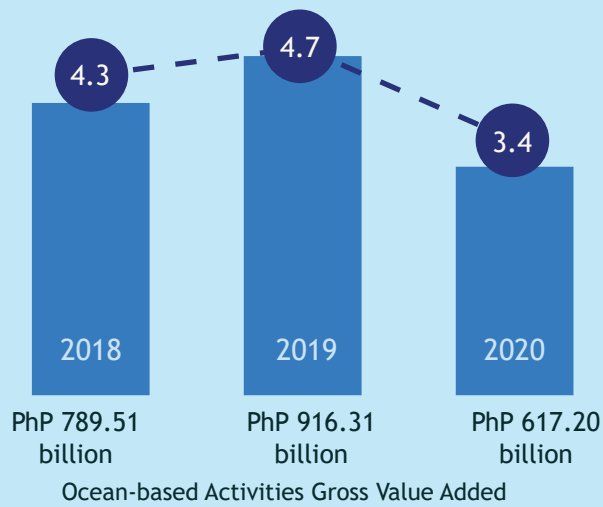




Ocean Economy refers to the economic activities that take place in the ocean, conducted near the ocean, receive outputs from the ocean and provide inputs to the ocean.



SHARE OF OCEAN ECONOMY TO GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT 2018-2020



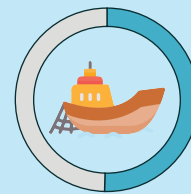
In 2020, Ocean Economy declined by

INDUSTRIES WITH HIGHEST OCEAN-BASED EMPLOYMENT, 2020



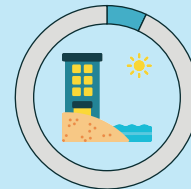

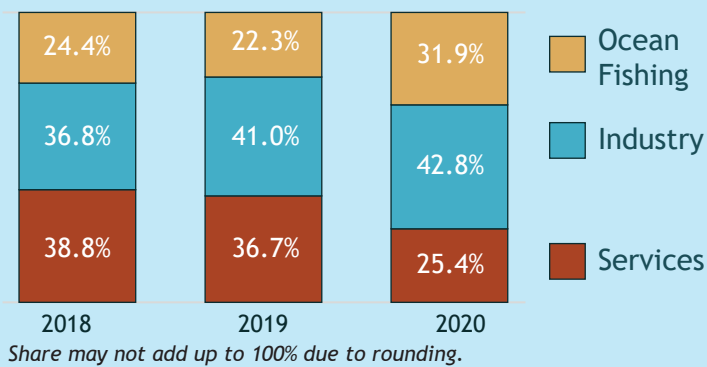

OCEAN ECONOMY BY INDUSTRY 2018-2020

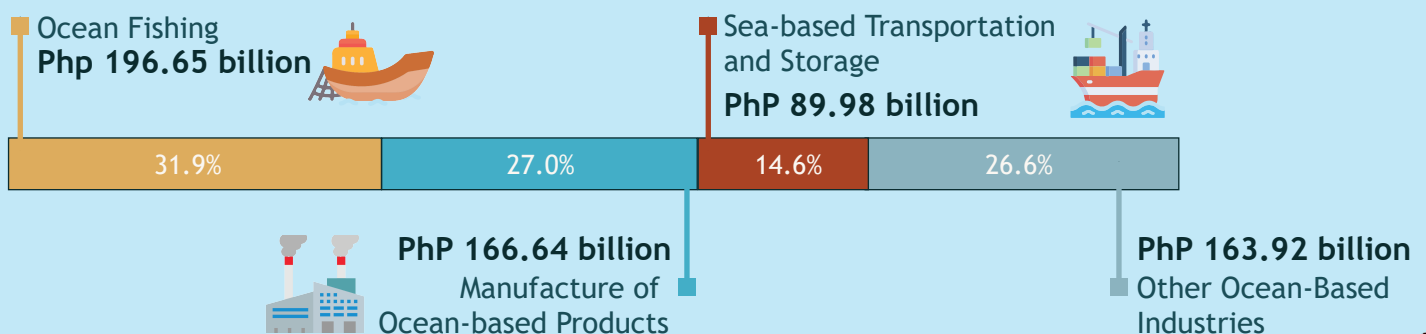


Ocean-based employment shared
