The Philippine Statistical Development Program (PSDP) is the National Strategy for the Development of Statistics of the Philippines. It is a mechanism for setting the directions, thrusts, and priorities of the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) which contains statistical development programs (SDPs) and activities for the medium-term. The PSDP serves as a tool for integrating and coordinating the statistical activities in the PSS.
