

## PSA Memorandum Order No. \_\_06 \_\_\_ Series of 2023

## RECONSTITUTING AND RENAMING THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON INFRASTRUCTURE STATISTICS TO INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE STATISTICS

WHEREAS, the Interagency Committee on Infrastructure Statistics (IACInfraStat) was established through PSA Memorandum Order No. 01, Series of 2022, to serve as a venue for discussion and resolution of issues, review current techniques/methodologies, and recommend policies and workable schemes towards the improvement of infrastructure and other related statistics;

**WHEREAS**, one sector that is closely related to infrastructure and which poses a great impact on the everyday lives of the Filipinos is the transportation sector;

**WHEREAS**, the generation of accurate, reliable, and timely statistics on transportation and infrastructure statistics is indispensable in planning and policymaking and can be achieved thru the collaborative efforts of concerned agencies;

WHEREAS, IAC member agencies recommended that the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), having under its jurisdiction other government agencies and local government units (LGU) and Bureau of Treasury (BTr) which can further contribute to the development of transportation and infrastructure statistics, be included as members of the IACInfraStat;

WHEREAS, in view of the expanded scope and membership of the IACInfraStat, it is imperative to reconstitute and rename the IAC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the IACInfraStat be renamed to Interagency Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure Statistics (IACTIS) and to include DILG and BTr as members;

**RESOLVED FURTHER,** that the IACTIS shall have the following composition and terms of reference:

Representatives from other agencies and/or other organizations shall be invited as the need for them arises.

## The IACTIS is tasked to:

- Serve as a forum for the exchange of views and expertise to resolve technical issues and problems arising from the generation, allocation and utilization of transportation and infrastructure statistics;
- Discuss and identify development programs concerning transportation and infrastructure statistics for inclusion in and/or updating the Philippine Statistical Development Program (PSDP);
- Identify and coordinate with relevant development partners to support priority statistical programs on transportation and infrastructure statistics in accordance with national policies;
- 4. Recommend an efficient workable scheme in strengthening sustainability of transportation and infrastructure statistics; and
- 5. Perform such other functions as may be deemed necessary/critical for the sector and the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) in general.

The Committee may establish Technical Working Groups (TWGs) and Task Forces (TFs), as the need arises, to assist in the exercise of its functions, subject to the approval of the National Statistician and Civil Registrar General (NSCRG). For effective conduct of meetings, a quorum must be determined. Technical, secretariat, and logistics support to the TWGs/TFs shall be provided by the PSA and concerned agencies. Other member agencies are enjoined to give the same support whenever deemed necessary.

The Committee shall adhere to the PSA Guidelines for Interagency Committees, Technical Committees, Technical Working Groups, Task Forces in the implementation of its activities and in the preparation of reports and recommendations. It shall submit to the NSCRG its work program and shall report on the progress of its work, including the findings and recommendations on issues referred to it.

This Memorandum Order takes effect on <u>29 May</u> 2023.
