

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# TO DISPLACED WORKERS AFFECTED BY THE ECONOMIC CRISIS: 1998



#### **BACKGROUND**

This report presents summary statistics on the various assistance/intervention packages provided by ÜOLE Offices to distressed companies and displaced workers affected by the current economic crisis for calendar year 1998.

Information on this report were preliminary statistics generated from different DOLÊ agencies, mainly: the National Conciliation and Mediation Board (NCMB); Bureau of Rural Workers (BRW); Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA); statistics submitted by DOLE Regional Offices

to the Bureau of Local Employment (BLE) and the DOLE Statistical Performance and Reporting System (SPRS).

#### **REPORT H1GHL1GHTS**

For 1998, a total of 21,247 workers from establishments and rural workers whose employment were adversely affected by the economic crisis were given direct assistance DOLE Comprehensive under the for displaced Workers. Program Other assistance in the form of issuance of verification certificates for SSS loans and job counseling were granted to some 34,177 workers and 18,981 workers, respectively. (Table I)

#### ■ Job Loss Prevention Program

For 1998, the NCMB settled a total of 109 cases involving establishment closures/retrenchments of workers due to current economic crisis. Through its conciliation and mediation program, the Board was able to save jobs for some 4,042 workers in 31 companies.

Similarly, DOLE Regional Offices of NCR, IIÎ and IX conducted series of dialogues with distressed companies to adopt measures to save or minimize job losses. Through these initiatives, some 243 workers in about 9 (nine) companies were able to preserve their jobs.

#### ☐ Facilitation of Separation Pay Packages for Retrenched Workers

In companies where closure o' establishments became inevitable, advisory/counseling services were provided by NCMI to enable the displaced worker; obtain the best separation pa' packages and ensure prompt release of funds. These activities facilitated the payment of an estimated P 300 million as separation pay for 3,804

displaced workers in 26 companies.

Plant level dialogues were also conducted by DOLE-NCR in establishments that resulted in million the release of P 3.5 separation benefits to about 444 workers. Similar retrenched were undertaken dialogues other DOLE ROs benefiting the following number of workers: 232 in Caraga. 168 in Region III (involving P 400,000), 46 in Region IX and 5 in Region VIII. (Table 3)

#### ☐ Employment Facilitation Assistance

Some 18,981 displaced worker.' were registered in the various Public Employment Service Offices (PESOs) and DOLE ROs nationwide possible employment assistance. Of this number, 3,569 applicants were hired or found employment in establishments or given training and financial assistance for self-employment. The bulk of the job placements were reported in Caraga (1,573), Region XII (739) Region I (449), Region III (306) and NCR (183).

#### □ Rural Works Program

As of the first quarter of 1999, various rural infrastructure funded under projects Rural Works Program has generated employment to some 4,837 displaced workers. The bulk of benefited workers from this program were in the Mindanao regions, namely. Caraga (1,549), Region IX (782), Region XI (682), Region XÎÎ (665) and Region X (263). The rest were in CAR (322). Region I (351) and Region III (223).

## □ Safety Net Training Grant Scheme (TESDA)

For 1998, some 1,549 retrenched workers availed of the various skills training and retraining courses offered by

TESDA under the Safety Net Training Grant Scheme.

### □ Special Action Programs for Sugar Workers

This program benefited some 2,308 workers in Region I (1,000), Region III (250) and Region VIII (1,058). Under this program, workers were given sacks of rice and medical assistance.

## ☐ Issuance of Verification Certification for SSS Loans

DOLE regional offices also issued verification certificates to more than 34,000 displaced workers who availed of the emergency loan program of the SSS. (Table 2)
