### **Best Youth Group Advocate for Statistics**

All youth organizations in the private and public universities and colleges, LGUs and other sectors of the society, which conducted statistical advocacy activities from January to December 2015, can send entries for this category. Government agencies and private organizations can nominate youth organizations with outstanding efforts in promoting statistics in various venues and formats, provided that sufficient documentation is submitted by the nominated youth organizations to merit the evaluation of the 26<sup>th</sup> NSM Awards Board of Judges.

The criteria for judging the entries in the Best Youth Group Advocate for Statistics are as follows:

Diversity and number of statistical activities	25%
Clarity of objectives/message and promotion of statistical awareness/literacy	25%
Outputs, outcomes and impacts of the statistical activities to the youth	25%
Extent of participation/Coverage	20%
Economy in the use of resources	5%
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>100%</b>
