Personnel for the Philippine Identification System - Project Management Office (PhilSys-PMO) Terms of Reference

I. Background

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) as the primary implementing agency of the Philippine Identification System will conduct a project on the development of the national identification system for 2018.

The National ID System is envisioned to introduce a national ID to all citizens and resident aliens in the Philippines that will also serve as a social and economic platform of the public and private entities in the country in providing a seamless service delivery, enhancing administrative governance, reducing corruption, strengthening financial inclusion, and promoting ease of doing business.

The implementation of NIDS has two (2) phases: 1) Pilot Phase to register the poorest of the poor, DSWD beneficiaries, IPs and senior citizens; 2) Phase 2 covers the whole population of the country.

Prior to the implementation of the pilot phase, this PhilSys Project Team expects to have the following key outputs and activities:

- a.) Undertake information campaign to promote PhilSys;
- b.) Coordinate to PhilSys consultants with regards to technical specifications of PhilSys;
- c.) Provide technical specifications in PhilSys with respect to its technical requirements (e.g. system, architecture, registration, conformance of hardware, de-duplication, and authentication)
- d.) Conduct bidding and procurement process for the PhilSys;
- e.) Carry out pilot testing on registration and ID production; and
- f.) Develop central and frontline capacity for steady state.

Hence, there is a need for experienced and technically capable personnel to man and monitor the development of the national identification system for nine (9) months starting on April to December 2018.

II. Project Team Needed

A. One (1) Assistant Project Manager (Php58,717.00/month)

- Assists the Project Team Leader in the development of the technical and functional specifications of software and hardware in terms of the following requirements of PhilSys;
- 2. Assists in the evaluation performance of the PhilSys infrastructure (hardware and software) and analysis technical developments;

- 3. Supervises and coordinates the work of other IT personnel within the Project Team;
- 4. Prepares the work plan, budget, and procurement plans pertaining to NIDS Project;
- 5. Conducts, evaluates and analyzes feasibility studies and researches on improvement of quality assurance processes of PhilSys;
- Recommends plans for the training of personnel in terms of fraud and investigation, ID
 production and operation, and registration and biometrics capture, authentication, and
 other related-trainings for the PhilSys;
- 7. Echoes or cascades acquired knowledge from training/workshops/study visits/seminars; and
- 8. Performs other tasks that may be assigned by supervisor/s.

B. Three (3) Project Team Leader (Php42,099.00/month)

- 1. Supervises and coordinates the work of all personnel under his/her supervision;
- 2. Makes assessments and analyzes the development of PhilSys infrastructure during the installation and testing and provide recommendations;
- 3. Identifies and evaluates the infrastructure (software/hardware) that will meet the PhilSys requirements;
- 4. Provides technical assistance to the PhilSys in the context of systems development including outsourced software;
- 5. Prepares documentation including technical descriptions on systems testing, on the adherence to coding and programming standards, and on the validation of accompanying systems documentation and operating manuals;
- Coordinates and conducts the orientation and training of personnel involved in systems
 development and systems implementation on PhilSys management principles and
 processes;
- 7. Echoes or cascades acquired knowledge from trainings/workshops/study visits/seminars; and
- 8. Performs other tasks that may be assigned by supervisor/s.

C. Three (3) Assistant Project Team Leader (Php31,765.00/month)

- 1. Assists in the formulation of standards and procedures for the PhilSys management during the pilot testing;
- 2. Implements, improves, and maintains strategies for keeping the PhilSys highly available and secure;
- 3. Prepares documentation and reports by collecting, analyzing and summarizing information and trends including failed processes and corrective actions;
- 4. Conducts system management, performance, and data security-related research pertaining to Philsys;
- Keeps personal IT skills and knowledge up to date and exploring opportunities for personal growth;
- 6. Participates in the training programs of PhilSys; and
- 7. Performs other tasks that may be assigned by supervisor/s.



D. Two (2) Information System Analysts (Php22,149.00/month)

- 1. Assists the Project Team Leaders in collaborating with PhilSys counterparts;
- 2. Develops the programs/modules assigned, in collaboration with his/her respective PhilSys-PMO Team;
